We had no new students today, so we started the class with the **Multiple Step Routines** that incorporated the elementary steps as well as the free-leg steps we learned last week. Then we danced to **Highway 40 Blues** and **Little Bitty**.

Next we reviewed the new steps to be used in **Got Stung**. These include:
